Lower Sixth Geography Field Trip: **Monday 21st September 2009**

Dear Parent/Guardian,

A day of fieldwork has been organised for the Lower Sixth on Monday 21st September. We will be investigating river landforms and processes in Kingsdale, the Ingleton waterfall walk, and the river Lune. In one day we cover a significant part of the core physical unit for AS geography. Your son should come ready to work hard and ask questions about an important element of their course. Following the fieldtrip your son will be asked to complete a detailed write-up of the day.

We will be travelling in a coach, departing from school (Moorgate) at 09.00 a.m. and returning at approximately 15.45 pm. Boys should first register with their forms and then meet on Moorgate.

We shall be in the field all day and therefore it is important to come well equipped. Students should bring the following: suitable footwear (sturdy trainers, wellington boots or walking boots); casual clothing including a waterproof jacket; a packed lunch, clipboard and pencil. A plastic freezer bag to cover your notes is always a good idea.

To be most comfortable, it is wise to check the weather forecast before departure and prepare accordingly although it tends to be cooler and wetter in the Yorkshire Dales where we are going.

With increasing costs of transport we would appreciate a contribution of £7.00 per person. This money should be brought as a cheque or cash in an envelope with your son's name on and handed to Mrs Oversby in the office together with the attached consent form. Please take time to fill out the consent form because we will use this for all the trips this term.
