Health and Safety

Rules on the trip:

These are kept to a minimum and are to preserve the safety of your son and to ensure that the trip is enjoyable for the whole group:

- i) No consumption of alcohol at any point except with consent of staff. This includes on the journeys.
- ii) Seat belts must be worn. Students should stay in groups of 3 when not directly supervised.
- iii) A clear curfew time will be set, depending on activities during the day. After this time students must remain in their own rooms, unless there is an emergency or they need to contact staff.
- iv) Fire escapes will be pointed out. Once in Dublin, and Belfast, maps will be available and contact details of staff. Boys must carry these with them at all times.
- v) **It is of particular importance that boys are sensitive to the tensions existing within sections of the Belfast communities.**

Please fill in the Medical and dietary consent form including European Health Insurance number (on the front of the card) and return to Christine Oversby in the school office.

Emergency contact details will be sent/available at the meeting/will be sent.

In the event of a serious problem at home that we and/or your son need to know about, you should contact Mr Whitehouse; his number will be on the contacts sheet. He will then contact us.

The final cost will be £ 500.00.

This is due to the poor rate of exchange with the Euro. Price includes flights, food, accommodation, Minivan Hire and a driver for the days required. All tours, guides etc.

Anything left will be returned.

Everyone has paid the £100 deposit. Please ensure that school has received the balance of £400 by 12th November. (Boys receiving a Lune scholarship may have a different total balance to pay.)
