You **must** bring your own headphones.

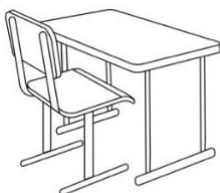


Bring a laptop if you have one, if you haven't let school know.

Get fresh air at break times.



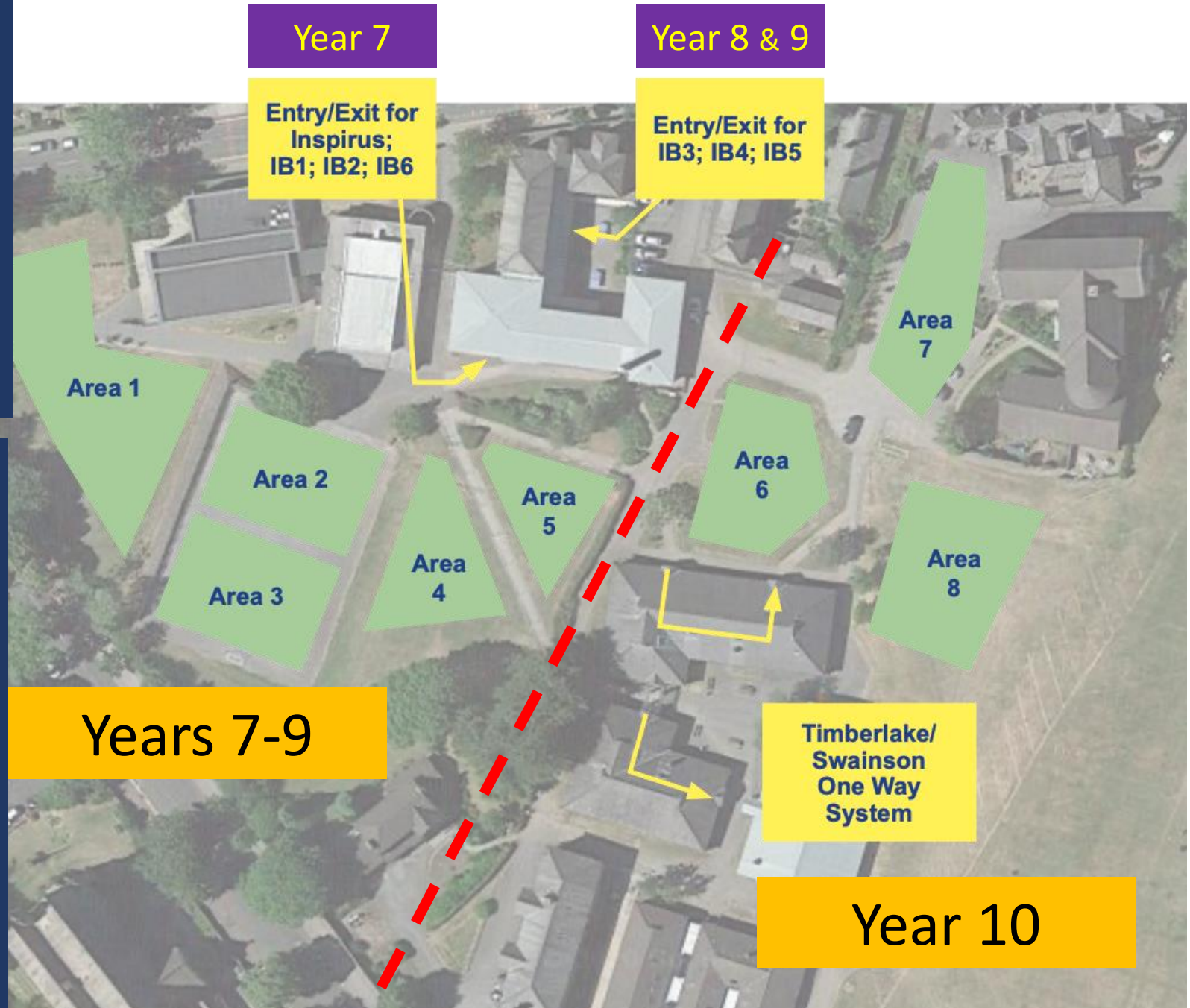
## Where should I go?

The Lower School are based in the International Building.

Year 7s **must** use the main entrance.

Years 8 & 9 **must** use the entrance from the courtyard by the table tennis tables.

Year 10 are located in the Timberlake building and **must** use the one-way system.



## What happens at breaks and lunchtime?

Pupils are allocated areas to use at break and lunchtime.

Years 7 – 9 use areas 1 to 5;  
Year 10 use areas 6 to 7.
