The Direct Debit Guarantee

- This Guarantee is offered by all banks and building societies that accept instructions to pay Direct Debits
- If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit Lancaster Royal Grammar School will notify you 10 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request Lancaster Royal Grammar School to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request.
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by Lancaster Royal Grammar School or your bank or building society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society.
- If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when Lancaster Royal Grammar School asks you to.
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.

GIFT AID DECLARATION

We can reclaim tax on all gifts made under the Gift Aid scheme, which means that every £10 you donate is worth £12.50 to the School.

- 1. You must pay enough income tax and / or capital gains tax to cover the amount of tax that all charities you donate to will reclaim in the tax year (currently 25p for each £1 you give) otherwise HMRC may ask you to pay any difference.
- 2. Other taxes that you pay such as VAT or council tax do not qualify for Gift Aid relief.
- 3. If in future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains to cover the amount of tax reclaimed through Gift Aid you may cancel your declaration
- 4. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief on your Self Assessment tax return
