Culinary Chemists success


Congratulations to our Chemistry students who excelled in the recent RSC Schools' Analyst competition, the challenge this year centred around making the perfect fish and chips.

Year 7 residential trips


We were delighted to be able to start the Year 7 residential trips again this year, the weather, to put it mildly, was "mixed" but it was a great experience for everyone involved.

Sixth Form Geography field trip


