CCF ARMY SECTION ANNUAL CAMP 8TH TO 14TH JULY 2023

I realise that the summer is still a long time ago and am writing to you now to help plan for the summer holiday. We are planning to hold summer camp at Kirkcudbright in Scotland, parading at LRGS at 08:00 and returning for 17:00 at the end of camp.

The training is still to be finalised but is hoped to include the following: tactics, blank firing, range practice, navigation and adventure training.

I hope that your son / daughter / ward will attend as it is the culmination of his/her training this year and he/she will thoroughly enjoy it! I hope you will choose to pay the £130 which is the cost of the camp after a large subsidy from the Army. To make it easier to pay please provide a portion of the cost now in the form of a deposit of £60, a further payment of £70 will be requested later. Wisepay will be available from Monday and payments should be made on Wisepay under **General Payments**, CCF Army Summer camp 23, with the deposit paid before 1st April. It is hoped to find places for all cadets who wish to attend camp but places are limited and will be allocated after 1st April on the basis of seniority. In the event that money has been received but the camp is cancelled for example due to coronavirus or a place is not available then this will be refunded otherwise all payments are non-refundable. For those who are unable to afford the full price of camp the Opportunities Fund may be able to help, please contact me directly about this. A kit list and forms for medical and other details will follow. A swim test will be necessary for the adventure training.

The sixth form cadets will be taken out for a meal in a local pub/restaurant. As such they will be allowed with your permission to drink a single small glass of port approx 75ml with the meal in order to make the loyal toast to the King.
