Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing with details of our plans for the third and fourth days of industrial action by the National Education Union (NEU) next **Wednesday 15th and Thursday 16th March.**

I am sorry that once again we will not be able to open the school as normal on those dates. The school will be open to the same year groups as for previous strike days, but we also plan to provide some live lessons on Teams in all year groups that are not in school.

Next Wednesday and Thursday the school will be open to the following students:

- Year 11, Lower Sixth and Upper Sixth students
- Boarders in all year groups
- Pupils identified as requiring individual support and those entitled to free school meals who may be supervised in school

The school will not be open for pupils in Years 7, 8, 9 and 10.

Teachers who are not part of the industrial action will provide some **live lessons on Teams for pupils in Years 7 to 10** in their normal timetabled periods for that day, which pupils should attend from home. We will ask teachers to schedule lessons in advance on Teams so that pupils have an idea which lessons are likely to go ahead. Please find attached some instructions for pupils on the use of Teams.

The English trip to Liverpool will go ahead as planned. If possible, some scheduled sports fixtures will also go ahead.

I am sorry for the disruption that this will cause. These are the final scheduled strike dates for now.
