The NHS recruitment and training body, Health Education England (HEE), confirmed funding for a new Medical Doctor Degree Apprenticeship in January. Apprentices will earn a wage while training to nationally recognised standards, and like most degree apprenticeships, they won't have to pay any tuition fees. 

UniTasterDays

Use <u>UniTasterDays</u> to search for University Events - there are a mixture of in person and online events that cover generic topics as well as subject specific options. If you need more information, each event tells you how to enquire/get in touch with the university. This will be helpful for anyone who isn't sure about university yet or those who know they definitely want to go. Remember, the more you take part in, the more of an informed choice you can make about your future.





ERS apprenticeships or employment in the future, having work experience on your application shows your commitment to the industry/subject area, that you have developed key skills and have been dedicated to complete a programme. You will receive a certificate at the end of the programme.



Research the career you're interested in - it is never to early (or too late) to learn about a new career! You can use a career website, university website, employer website or YouTube to research and find out more. Simply search "How can I become a X in the UK" on the internet (of course, you need to replace the X with the job role you're interested in).



Not sure on the job role you're interested in? That's ok too! - Check out the <u>UCAS Careers Quiz</u> which will ask you a series of questions then match you too a list of job roles that you may be interested in.

Make a UCAS Hub account - this is a great way to explore your University AND apprenticeship options in readiness for your future. Once you have an account, there are <u>lots of features you</u> <u>can take advantage of.</u>
