Dear Parents and Guardians,

The biology department is linking with Dr Emma Shawcross, a teaching fellow in the Biomedical and Life Science department at Lancaster University. Dr Shawcross has worked closely with LRGS biology to plan a variety of educational activities to complement the content taught in the AQA A-level Biology specification. The activities will take place in the Health Innovation Centre (HIC) on the university campus.

This is an exciting opportunity. The students will be working with biomedical undergraduates and have access to the facilities at this highly ranked university. The activities aim to inspire LRGS A-level biology students in the fields of human physiology, biotechnology, genetics and immunology.
