GCSE RESULTS DAY

Thursday 22nd August:

Students can access results via e-portal in the same way that grades and reports have been accessed using existing user names and passwords. Results will be on-line from 8.00am.

If students wish, they can come in to school and collect the results slips personally from the Assembly Hall between 10.00 am and 10.45 am.

Written authorisation for a third party to collect results is required if a person other than the student is unable to access the results online and is unable to collect them in person.

Due to issues of confidentiality results will not be disclosed over the telephone.
