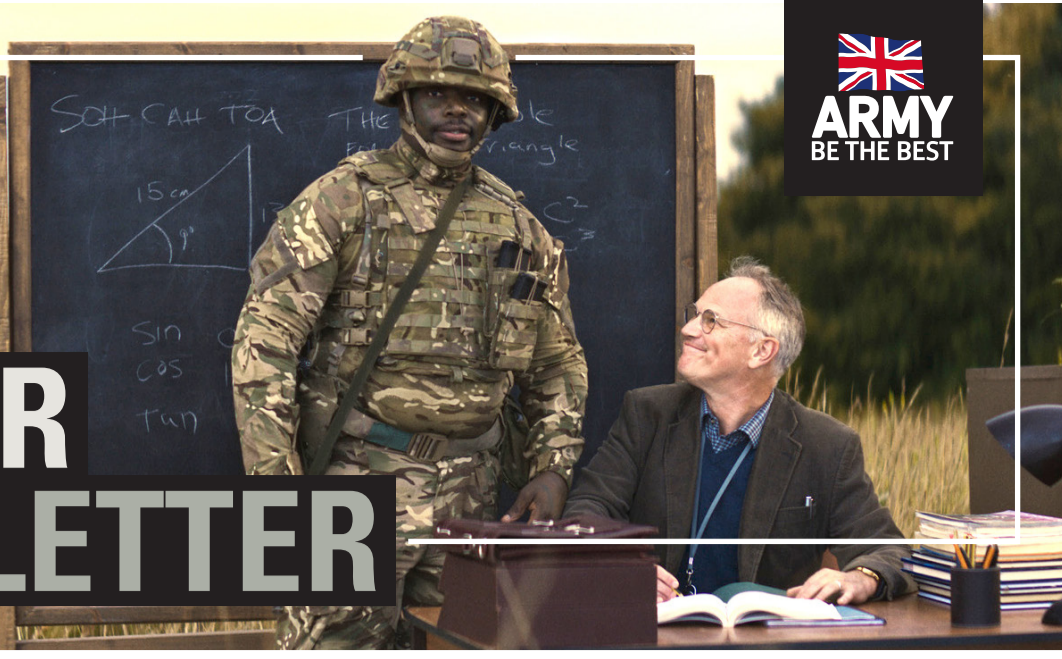

FINANCIAL SUPPORT

SCHOLARSHIP

Receive up to £10,000 through the Army Officer Scholarship Scheme starting in Year 13. Secure a place at Sandhurst and begin your Army Officer career. Apply for additional bursaries like the Enhanced, DSUS, or Medical Bursary at university.

INTERNSHIP

Experience a challenging year as an Army Officer through the paid Army Internship Programme. Train at Sandhurst, shadow officers, and lead soldiers. Enjoy sports, adventurous training, and military exercises. Gain leadership and management skills. Choose to continue as a Reservist or pursue another career path.

DEGREE WHILE SERVING

Get a fully-funded degree with the Army. Train at Sandhurst for 42 weeks, earning a BSc in Leadership and Strategic Studies. Continue your studies alongside your career without fees. Already have a degree? Apply for the Army's MSc program in Leadership and Strategic Studies.

ARMY BURSARIES

STANDARD BURSARY UP TO £7000

The Standard Army Undergraduate Bursary is open to undergraduates interested in joining the Army as an Officer after university. £6,000 is typically paid to you throughout your course (£7,000 for four-year degrees).

ENHANCED BURSARY UP TO £24000

The Enhanced Army Undergraduate Bursary offers up to, £24,000 to students with at least ABB at A-Level, expecting a 2:1 degree or higher, and demonstrating potential Officer qualities.

MEDICAL BURSARIES UP TO £75,000

Apply in your first or second year. Receive £10,000 (£5,000 for Vet and Pharmacy) annually in your final three years. Work as a medical cadet, and get a £45,000 (£36,000 for Pharmacists) lump sum after Sandhurst.

NURSING STUDENTS

There are two ways to fund your nursing degree: either with an Officer Nursing Bursary, or by studying nursing as a paid Soldier. You can apply for an Army Officer Nursing Bursary with an unconditional offer to study nursing (at a University of your choice) and you'll receive a £5,000 bursary per year. Upon completion of your initial military training, you will receive a lump sum of £27,000.

DEFENCE STEM UNDERGRADUATE SPONSORSHIP (DSUS) UP TO £42,750

Receive up to £42,750 (£5k yearly bursary + tuition fees) for STEM students commissioning into the Royal Engineers, Royal Signals, Royal Logistic Corps, Royal Electrical Mechanical Engineers, Royal Artillery, Adjutant General's Corps, Army Air Corps, or Intelligence Corps.
