## School priorities:

### Learn

- (a) Curriculum intent: Review and fine-tune schemes of work to ensure appropriate consistency and detail, with particular focus on Year 10
- (b) Support departments to embed self-evaluation including use of pupil voice and book looks, and continue to learn from departmental spotlights

### Reflect

- (c) Promote positive behaviour and attitudes in all students, and develop new leadership and role model opportunities
- (d) Lead environmental and social initiatives that will have a positive impact locally and globally

### Grow

- (e) Annual Fund: Promote the broadest extra-curricular programme and ensure its financial sustainability by increasing income and support for the Annual Fund
- (f) Provide new opportunities for deep and creative thinking, and for practical engagement with employers and other external organisations

- (g) Use our new SEND provision mapping to plan, track and evaluate our support for pupils
- (h) Review our well-being surveys and use data to target mental health support effectively
