MUSIC LESSONS AT LRGS

Welcome to the Music Department at Lancaster Royal Grammar School! We are delighted that you are interested in taking music lessons with one of our music tutors. We have an excellent group of Peripatetic Music Teachers at LRGS and your son/daughter may wish to continue having their music lessons here. Your son/daughter may also wish to take up an instrument for the first time or start learning an additional instrument.

The music lessons are 30 minutes long and are on a one-to-one basis, at a charge of £19.50 per lesson. These usually take place during the school day on a rotating timetable, which hopefully reduces any impact on the academic timetable. Priority for lessons outside of the academic timetable is given to GCSE and A Level students. If a student needs to excuse themselves from a school lesson, they should inform the teacher at the beginning of the lesson and then ask to leave for the instrumental tuition (allowing enough time to get to the practice room). Similarly, after the music tuition, they should proceed to their next lesson. Students must ensure that they catch up on any missed work.

All music lessons take place in the practice rooms in the Music Department or the Music Practice Room in Old School House. Full details and any door codes will be emailed out to you in advance of the lesson.

From September 2025 we will undertake to provide 34 lessons over the school year. The amounts payable are shown below and reflect the number of lessons teachers aim to provide each term. Payments are made

in advance, at the start of every half term.

Lessons will not commence without this contract being signed and returned (use the link below) and payment having been made. If there are financial issues regarding the fees, please contact Ms Price as soon as possible.

INSTRUMENTS

It is important that students have their own instrument for music lessons as practice between lessons is an important part of progress. There are only a limited number of certain instruments available in the Music Department, and these cannot be removed from the Department. There is a secure storage room in the Music Department, near the practice rooms, where your instrument may be stored during the school day.
