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### Year 10 Geography Fieldtrip: 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> July 2019

Dear Parents/Guardians,

I am writing to inform you that the **Geography Department** has organised a day of GCSE field-work for Year 10 Geographers on the following days:

<b>Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> July</b> <b>10G1(IWL), 10G2(KJP)</b>	<b>Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> July</b> <b>10G4(AMT), 10G3(IWL)</b>
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We will be investigating the fantastic glacial scenery of the Lake District near Grasmere, exploring Easdale tarn. During the field study we will be collecting data for our GCSE Physical Geography Fieldwork Assignment. The title of the assignment is "Temperature reduces with altitude". This will involve a walk of approximately 5.5 miles. In addition we will examine glacial landforms, the impact of tourism in the Lake District and management of tourism.

The field-work is designed to give boys a better appreciation of geographical fieldwork and a valuable learning experience outside the classroom.

We will be travelling by coach, leaving Lancaster at 9.00 a.m. and returning at approximately 16.15 p.m. Boys should meet on Moorgate at 08.50 to be registered on the bus. Because boys will be out of school for lunch it will be necessary for your son to bring a packed lunch with him.

It is important that boys come suitably clothed as it is impossible to guarantee fine weather. This should include strong footwear, warm clothing and a waterproof cagoule or jacket. Each pupil will need to bring a pencil to write with, and a file or clip-board to provide a surface for writing on. It is always wise to bring these in a plastic bag to protect written work from any rain. In previous years strong sunshine meant a water bottle, sun cream and a sun hat were most essential; it may be the same this year!

I would be very grateful if you could pay a contribution of £15.00 towards the cost of the trip via wise pay. The attached permission slip should be returned by your son to their geography teacher.
