All texts need to be purchased, but most are available cheaply second hand, and even new should cost no more than £30.

Wider reading is always encouraged! It's a good idea to purchase and familiarise yourself with the set texts, but don't worry if you find them hard going, most people do at first but you will soon get used to it when we work on them in class. The fiction of Sartre is accessible and a good introduction to his philosophy. Richard Dawkins is also recommended reading; we don't necessarily think he's right but he's fun to criticise.
