Lower Sixth Geography Fieldtrip, Great Langdale, Monday 30th March 2020

A geography fieldtrip has been organised for this term on Monday 30th March to Great Langdale in the Lake District. The coach will depart from Moorgate at 08.50 and will finish at 15.30 p.m. back in Lancaster. Your son or daughter should be registered on the coach at 08.50.

The purpose of the Great Langdale fieldtrip is to give students detailed case studies of a range of spectacular glacial landforms very relevant to our study of glaciations.

For this fieldtrip to be a success it is essential that students come prepared with the right equipment. The equipment for the day will be as follows: Suitable outdoor clothing including waterproof top and bottoms, walking boots, hat and gloves, a spare warm top, and fieldwork writing equipment (notebook, clipboard, pen, pencil, plastic bag to keep notes dry). A camera is optional as it might get wet. All this should be brought in a small rucksack lined with a waterproof bag. You should also bring a packed lunch, snacks and drink (possibly a thermos). We will be out all day!

Responsible behaviour is expected at all times and all students must follow health and safety advice given to them.
